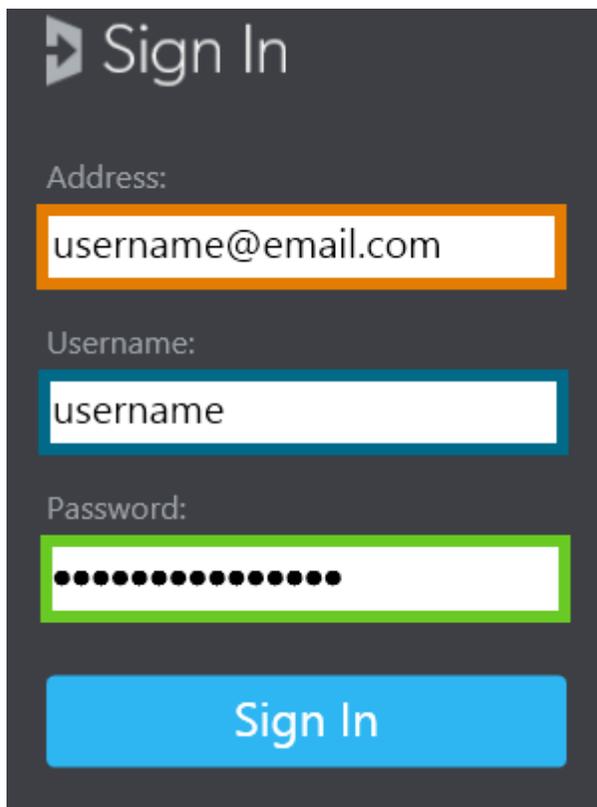
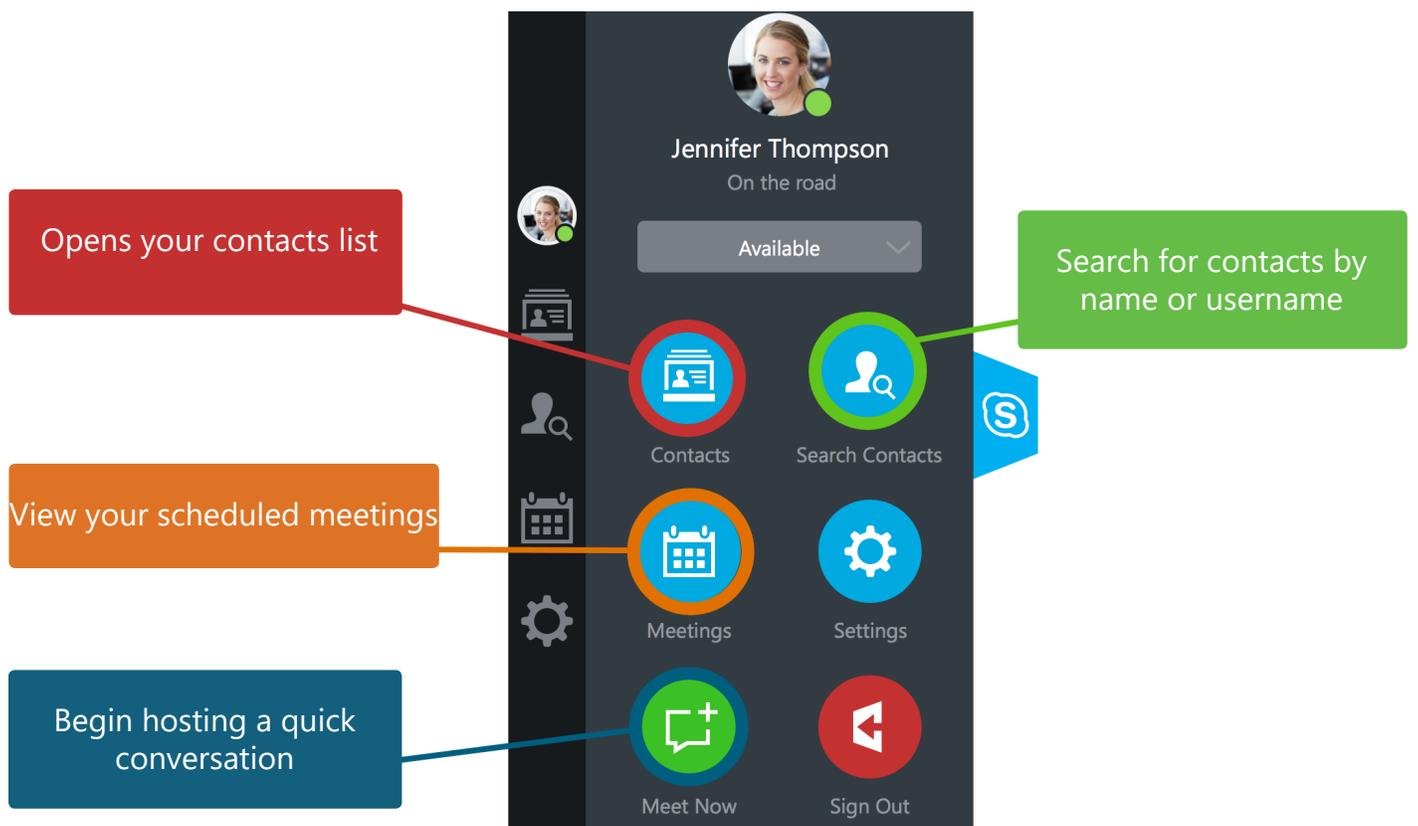


Sign In

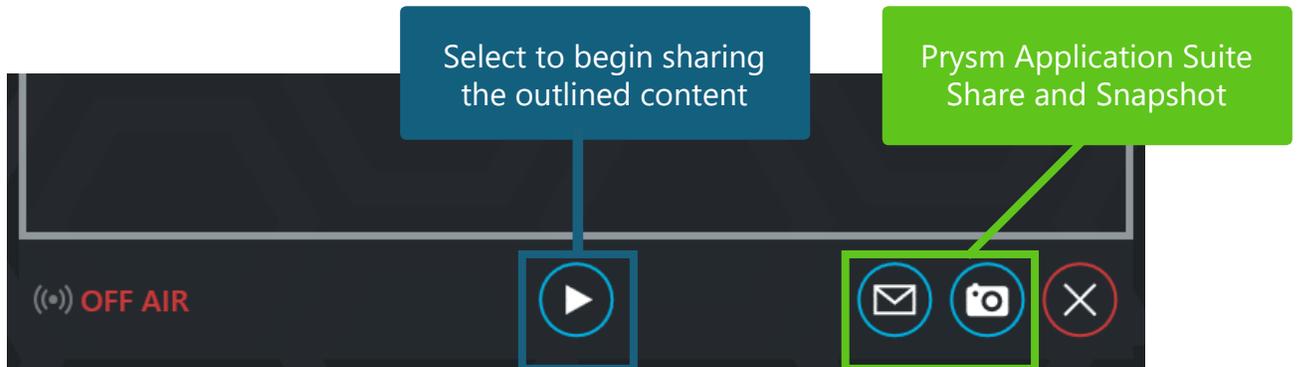
If the Skype for Business panel is closed, the tab will subtly flash to signify that you have an incoming call
